**Worms Eat our Trash!** (Pre-K to 5<sup>th</sup> Grade)— Participants will learn introductory information about composting; how worms turn our trash into healthy soil for happy plants; demonstration of how composting with a worm bin works! *30 minutes*

**Recycling our Waste!** (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade)— Participants will learn about the process and benefits of composting; how composting connects to other environmental issues in our community; demonstrations of an aerobic (worm composting bin) and anaerobic process (bokashi) for recycling food waste and building healthy soil. *30-45 minutes*

**Waste Solutions: A Shared Responsibility** (9<sup>th</sup> Grade— Adults)— Participants will learn about the process and benefits of composting; connections between composting and broader environmental issues; household- and community-based solutions for recycling our waste and restoring soil for healthy gardens. *45-60 minutes*
